Tyson Grover presented information on Project Lead the Way Launch, an elementary project-based learning opportunity widely used in Davis District. Corresponding Project Lead the Way programs are almost universally used in the District's secondary schools. Mr. Grover shared statistics demonstrating the emotional, social and academic benefits of students learning to identify and solve problems. Teachers would be expected to become trained and then to teach one 10-hour module each year. After a question and answer period, the Council was strongly in favor of pursuing this opportunity. The initial cost would be \$12,000, with \$5,000 coming from the school and the District paying the remainder. (Subsequent years would cost \$750.)
